## CONCERT UNIFORM INFORMATION

**Year 7 Music students are required to wear formal school uniform (Ripieno, Year 7 Classical Guitar Ensemble, Year 7 Choirs, Junior Contemporary Ensemble, Wind Band 4)**

<b>Male</b>
<b>Long Trousers</b>
<b>White shirt (not polo)</b>
<b>School tie</b>
<b>Black school shoes (plain lace-up, flat heel)</b>
<b>NB:</b> Long hair to be tied back with neutral coloured hair bands

<b>Female</b>
<b>School Skirt</b>
<b>White shirt (not polo)</b>
<b>School tie</b>
<b>Stockings – Opaque tights</b>
<b>Black school shoes (plain lace-up, flat heel)</b>
<b>NB:</b> Minimal jewellery allowed, silver or gold only, including watches and simple earrings.

**Year 8 - 12 Male Music students are required to wear the Music Performance Uniform**

<b>Male</b>
<b>Black concert trousers</b>
<b>Black concert shirt</b>
<b>Blue concert tie</b>
<b>Black school shoes (plain lace-up, flat heel)</b>
<b>NB:</b> A black belt is required if the concert trousers have belt loops. Long hair to be tied back with neutral coloured hair bands

## Year 8 – 9 Female Music students are required to wear the NEW Music Performance Uniform

### Female

Blue concert blouse

Long black concert pants

**Stockings** – Knee high's acceptable. (colour: **nearly black** – not opaque)

**Black shoes** (low heel or wedge leather/leather-like), plain – no patent, buckles, bows, trims

(Optional): **Blue Scrunchie / Blue Ribbon**

**NB: Minimal jewellery** allowed, silver or gold only, including watches and simple earrings.

## Year 10 - 12 Female Music students are required to wear the Music Performance Uniform (Dress).

### Female

Long blue **concert dress** **If yours does not fit, please bring it to the Music Office to exchange for an alternative size.**

**Stockings** – Knee high's acceptable. (colour: **nearly black** – not opaque)

**Black shoes** (low heel or wedge leather/leather-like), plain – no patent, buckles, bows, trims

(Optional): **Blue Scrunchie / Blue Ribbon**

**NB: Minimal jewellery** allowed, silver or gold only, including watches and simple earrings.

### Concert Dresses and Trousers – Uniform Guide

It is essential that all music students adhere to the dress code for performances so they all look great.

The concert dress should sit **3cm from the floor** when wearing shoes.

The girls black pants must be those provided by Lowes.

Girls are to wear simple, plain, black court shoes with a small heel, plain black Mary Jane style, or Ballerina Flats with NO TRIMMINGS, with (nearly black) sheer stockings or knee-highs.

Boys' trousers should sit just above the shoe sole, and socks should be plain black and not show any ankle when sitting down.

Students with long hair need to tie their hair up with neutral coloured hair bands preferably the same colour as the hair. When using a scrunchie/ribbon, it should be put on / tied so that it covers the hair band.

### Guidelines for Girl's Concert Dresses

The concert dress (new) is sold without hemming so students can make sure that the length of the dress is **3cm from the floor** when wearing with shoes. **DO NOT cut off the bottom of your dress!**

Please get the dress professionally **HAND HEMMED** making sure that the hem width is up to 15cm inside. For some of the students, the overlapping neckline will need to be hand stitched to prevent gaping of the bodice.

### Other Items

Students can wear school track tops, V-neck jumpers or blazers if feeling cold when not performing.
